- *How do we ensure **honesty, openness, dialogue**?*



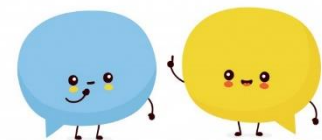
## II. ON SHARING INFO (SUCH AS THE ONE EARLIER)

- *EU offices, political representations, umbrella organisations + EU civil society – **any other options?***
- *How to share **what's happening in the EU** (projects, funding, opportunities, reflections)*
- *How to ensure „**direct line**“? Not ad hoc and project-based?*
- *Europe Direct, various contact points for EU programmes – **are they used to the full?***



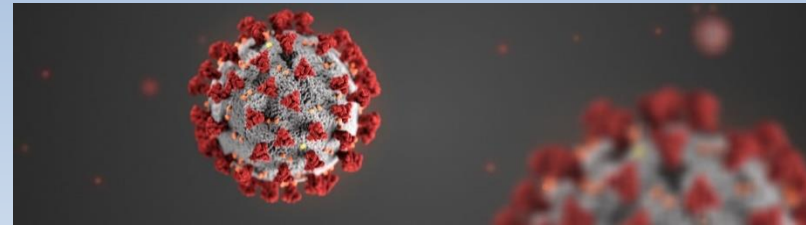
### **III. ON POLITICAL DIALOGUE (SUCH AS URBAN AGENDA)**

- *How can local actors link to **EU policy topics**?*
- *Green Deal, other **big priorities of the EU**?*
- *Discussions on **EU budget and programmes** – how local level gets involved?*
- *E.g. for **structural funds** – decided on national and EU level, but with interfaces for input from local (are cultural actors always properly involved?)*



## IV. ON COVID-19

- Solutions are **local, regional, national, EU** – how do we best „connect“ them and sync them?
- How can local **know about** EU, EU about local, national about local, etc.
